

MINUTES OF BOCC SPECIAL MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Grant County, Oklahoma (BOCC) held a special meeting on **Monday, March 30, 2026**, at 10:00 am. Notice of the Meeting, including agenda, was posted at both entrances of the Grant County Courthouse, Medford, OK, Thursday, March 26, 2026, prior to 10:00 am. in accordance with Title 25, §301-314 O.S.

Stinson called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. After roll call, a quorum was acknowledged. Present were Steve Stinson, Keith McClure, and Craig Fredrick. Also present were Rachelle McCaleb as Secretary, Penny Huff, and Danielle Deterding. Teleconferencing was enabled to comply with the Open Meetings Act.

Steve Stinson said a prayer and McClure led the flag salute.
