Hess attended a demonstration from Invex which is a road inventory software. This software would be very useful in tracking FEMA projects as well as other beneficial tracking. The floor was poured last week on the 2<sup>nd</sup> bridge. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> bridges will be poured today and there will be road closures between CR 910 to 920 for 2 to 3 weeks.

Fredrick reported Bridge 112 construction is coming along. D2 will be grading and attending to normal maintenance.

Stinson attended the ACCO conference on Wednesday. D3 is working on ditch projects as well as rock and shale projects.
