MINUTES OF BOCC REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Grant County, Oklahoma (BOCC) held a regular meeting **Monday, April 17, 2023,** at 9:00 am. Notice of the Meeting, including agenda, was posted at both entrances of the Grant County Courthouse, Medford, OK, Friday, April 14, 2023, by 9:00 am. in accordance with Title 25, §301-314 O.S.

Stinson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. After roll call, a quorum was acknowledged. Present were Steve Stinson, Craig A Fredrick, and Max L Hess. Also present were Robin Herod, Penny Huff, Jason Jump, Cindy Pratt, and Kristi Sproul from PSCO. Scott Falkenberg entered for Item 6q. Teleconferencing was enabled to comply with the Open Meetings Act.

Stinson offered the prayer and Fredrick led the flag salute.

Pratt acknowledged the agenda was properly posted in compliance with the Open Meeting Act.

Stinson opened the floor to Kristi Sproul of Public Service Co of Oklahoma formerly known as Rock Falls Wind Farms as of 03-31-23. Mrs. Sproul informed the board that PSCO is an electric utility company based in Tulsa, OK. They serve approximately ½ million customers in the eastern and southern part of Oklahoma. Mrs. Sproul stated their company is centrally assessed by the State and is governed by the Corporation Commission. Rock Falls was purchased for \$159 million. There are approximately 60 wind turbines in Grant County owned by PSCO. Mrs. Sproul also mentioned they are fully assessed in Major and Blaine Counties. PSCO is also very community engaged and looks forward to participating in county programs and agencies such as 4-H/FFA, Public Safety, Fire Dept, etc.

No new business.

Hess reported that CED#8 was awarded 1 of 9 national bridge grants. CED#8 was awarded a total of \$11.5 million. This grant will provide 7 bridges in the CED#8 district. Grant County D2 was awarded one of these bridge grants. This is good for all counties within the CED#8 district as it will free up funds for other projects. The OK Transportation Corp awarded a bid for a bridge in Grant Co D1 in the amount of \$1,140 million. Hess reported D1 is building bridges from the used material and 3 bridges are open and 2 more are being built and should be ready this week.

Fredrick reported business as usual.

Stinson attended the OPEH&W meeting in OKC. Ross Naylor will plan to come to Grant Co sometime in May to visit with each District and the CH/Sheriff's Office staff regarding the benefit package offered by our insurance. D3 is repairing a bridge NW of Nash but are waiting on concrete. D3 is hauling donated rock from an oilfield pad near Nash and laying on nearby roads. D3 continues working road but rain is needed. Stinson thanked Jason Jump for the article in the Medford Patriot Star informing the public of the Federal Govt 30 by 30 Land Preservation Goal.
