## MINUTES OF BOCC REGULAR MEETING

The Board of Commissioners of Grant County, Oklahoma (BOCC) held a regular meeting **Tuesday**, **May 28, 2024**, at 9:00 am. Notice of the Meeting, including agenda, was posted at both entrances of the Grant County Courthouse, Medford, OK, Friday, May 24, 2024, by 9:00 am. in accordance with Title 25, §301-314 O.S.

Fredrick called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. After roll call, a quorum was acknowledged. Present were Craig A Fredrick, Max L Hess, and Steve Stinson. Also present were Cindy Pratt, Penny Huff, and Donnie Head. Teleconferencing was enabled to comply with the Open Meetings Act. All three commissioners used their signature stamp.

This will be revisited on June 3, 2024, during the BOCC meeting.

No action on leases of ambulances & MOU for FY 24-25 as these agreements were executed on 05-20-24.

Stinson reported the balance of the insurance deductible fund through ACCO is approximately \$63,000. Therefore, funds are available for repairs of the 2018 Ford F150X Crew Cab pickup s/n ending 35916 for the Sheriff's Office.

Stinson moved to approve <u>Resolution 2024-67</u> – Surplus of 2021 John Deere 35G Mini Excavator, Inv #353.19 for District 3. Hess seconded. Fredrick – aye; Hess – aye; Stinson – aye; Motion carried.

Donnie Head presented the Report of Conference (ROC) for each district which details the bridge inspections. Head explained CED has a new billing system, and future invoices will emailed to the County Clerk for presentment to the board. Head will continue to present the ROC to the board each month in person prior to presentment of the invoice.

No new business.

Stinson thanked Donnie Head, Max Hess, and CED #8 for the work on the bridge project and the attention given to this project. Rain was received in District 3, so crews are hauling rock today. District 3 will be working on repairing roads and continued maintenance. District 3 is also working on low water crossing. Stinson will be out the rest of this week.

Hess reported the chip/seal project was completed last week, and he appreciates the help of the other districts employees. Hess appreciated that Garfield Co loaned a truck to Grant Co during this project as Grant Co had a truck breakdown and this helped until the truck could be repaired. District 1 is now grading and spraying intersections.

Fredrick reported District 2 started their chip/seal project last week but since rain is in the forecast, will wait until next week to continue with this project. District 2 will work on rutted roads this week.
