Stinson stated D3 - Will close Blake Kretchmar's road on Tuesday. Hauling rock. Mowing and repairing roads behind Grasshopper.

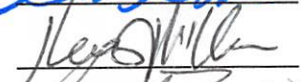

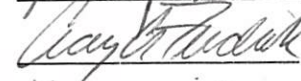

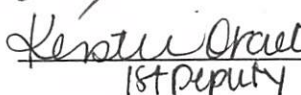
