Hess reported D1 has a grader that extensions are being put on. D1 has been mowing and hauling reclaimed rock from an oil pad. Hess was notified that D1 will get some reclaimed beams from Canadian County destructed bridges. Rating will be placed on these beams by CED #8, Tyler Schroder.

Fredrick reported D2 is working and grading the rock roads after moisture was received. D2 sold surplus equipment at auction with great success. These funds will be used for other needs within D2. The 2nd CHBP bridge project has begun and should take approximately 30 days to complete.

Stinson reported D3 is working on roads. D3 has 3 graders currently in service and are awaiting the delivery of 2 additional graders. As the holiday season approaches, employees will be taking vacation time prior to the end of the year. Stinson reported Oklahoma has approximately 25 counties under the population of 10,000. Stinson will reach out to some of these counties for discussion of the issues with the recently passed bill regarding the 3rd party vendor presenting documentation to the Equalization Board with regards to protested taxes.
