

## RESOLUTION 2022-174

**Whereas** Title 19 O.S. § 180.71 - 180.83 regards the Calculation of Annual County Officer Salary where personal property and livestock are exempt from property tax.

**Whereas** Grant County exempts personal property and livestock from property taxes.

**Whereas** Serviceability, population, and the mill rate of the county are used to calculate the basic salary of a county officer.

**Whereas**, effective July 1, 2022, salary for elected Grant County Officials is set as follows: Base Salary - \$44,500.00 Serviceability - \$10,800.00; Service Load Adjustment - \$50.00 for a Total Annual Salary of \$55,350.00 which does not include the annual gross payroll increase of \$5,000.

**Whereas** it is understood that adjustments to Basic and Serviceability will only take effect on the beginning of a new term. A maximum annual increase to the Total Annual Salary of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for elected officials will be in effect as follows: The District 1 Commissioner, the District 3 Commissioner, and the Assessor will have a salary increase adjustment effective as of January 1, 2023. The Treasurer salary increase adjustment will become effective July 1, 2023, in FY24. The District 2 Commissioner, the County Clerk, the Court Clerk, and the Sheriff salary increase adjustment will become effective January 1, 2025, in FY24.

**Therefore**, the gross pay increase adjustment of **\$416.66** per month will be reflected in the January 2023 payroll which will be disbursed in February 2023, to applicable elected officials. The gross payroll adjustment will increase the monthly gross salary from \$4,612.50 to **\$5,029.16** for the six (6) months of FY23 including: **January 2023** as disbursed in February, **February 2023** as disbursed in March, **March 2023** as disbursed in April, **April 2023** as disbursed in May, **May 2023** as disbursed in June, and **June 2023** as disbursed in July for District 1 Commissioner, District 3 Commissioner, and the Assessor.

Adjustment for the remaining elected officials will be calculated according to the Calculation of Annual County Officer Salary for the Fiscal Year it pertains to.


