Either party may terminate this agreement by, submitting to the other party, a written REQUEST FOR TERMINATION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT between Alfalfa County Resolution 2022-93. This written request must be postmarked or emailed to the other party within 30 days of the effective date.
