INTERLOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
between Alfalfa County and Grant County

The Interlocal Cooperative Act of Oklahoma Statutes 74 § 1001 et seq. enables county government to cooperate with each other to make the most efficient use of their powers and resources on a basis of mutual advantages.

This agreement was entered into this __ day of ___ 2022, by and between Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, Board of County Commissioners, party of the first part and the Grant County, Oklahoma, Board of County Commissioners, part of the second part.

It is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto that Alfalfa County will sell gravel to Grant County at a rate of \$0.80 per ton.

This agreement will be enforced from the above date through Fiscal Year 2022-23 and expires June 30, 2023.

Either party may terminate this agreement by, submitting to the other party, a written **REQUEST FOR TERMINATION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT between Alfalfa County Resolution and Grant County Resolution 2022-94**. This written request must be postmarked or emailed to the other party within 30 days of the effective date.




