## **FIREARMS/ WEAPONS**

Grant County wishes to maintain a work environment that is free of unauthorized firearms, weapons, explosives, and other dangerous materials. To achieve this goal, the County prohibits (except by other specific authorization) the use of the following items on County premises: Dangerous chemicals and explosives. Other objects carried for the purpose of injuring or intimidating other people may be considered dangerous items.

Pursuant to 2024 Oklahoma Statute Title 21-1277, employees working within or present in the Grant County Courthouse and county offices are authorized to possess a concealed handgun providing that employee possesses a valid license to carry a handgun, submits the required "Employee Application for Carrying Weapon at Work-Site", signs an information waiver, and is approved by the Sheriff.

Employees who work in field positions, not wanting to carry a concealed weapon when in the courthouse or county offices, who possess a valid license to carry a handgun, has signed an information waiver and provided a photocopy of a valid Oklahoma Self-Defense Act Handgun License to Grant County, may carry a concealed weapon while on work duty.

Employees shall provide a photocopy of a renewed Oklahoma Self-Defense Handgun License within thirty (30) days of renewal. Firearms may be present in an employee's unattended private vehicle on County property only if the vehicle is locked at all times. Employees violating this policy will be subjected to disciplinary action, up to and including separation. If any employee observes any dangerous items in violation of this policy on County property, the employee is under duty to report such items to the appropriate elected official.

Carrying a concealed weapon in courtrooms, Sheriff's Office, or any prisoner detention area is prohibited by law.
